Old Business:

Old Business List: Items were presented off the “Old Business List” which we use to track status of activities. Four items were resolved, including removal of dirt piles from re

-work of Cart Path #2, golf cars driving in hazard to be handled by course Player Assistants, mowing close to property line to left of # 17 green, and Titleist Cup standings have been posted on board. Seven items were deferred until Winter or Spring but will continue to be tracked.

14th Hole Green Cart

Path: The grass just right of cart path has been turned to hardpan due to people parking off the path. Temporarily, stakes and ropes have been installed to keep carts from pulling to the right of the path. Jeff has asked for a quote on concrete curbing which could be installed. Hardpan area will have to be corrected also.

Re-Stripe the Parking

Lot: Re-striping has been deferred to next year. Paint has been ordered and templates for directional arrows have been made, to address the safety issue.

PG&CC Management:

Jessica said that John

would be managing the Bar/Restaurant, and Ginny would be handling Events. Casey said the PG&CC Website is being improved. Stay tuned for more.

There will be another “Member Appreciation” happy hour in November. Look for an announcement.

Around the Board:

The next Sunday Couples Mixer will be October 23rd at 10:00 AM. This is the last Mixer scheduled this season and if you haven’t participated, give it try. Barb mentioned she had plaques printed for the Champions of the previous Couples Mixer. The expense was approved and Harley will get a check to pay for them.

Luann, Barb and Larry B. all voiced concern about the location of holes on the greens. In addition to not being placed on a somewhat flat area, they are at times placed in or next to a damaged area of the green. Previously, we discussed

that the holes are not always tamped down. Barb mentioned that on Taco Tuesday, orange oil was dripping from the food onto the plates. Jess said if you ever have a problem with the food, please bring it to the attention of the staff at the time. They'll get it fixed or get something else for you.

Barb suggested that when maintenance mowers cause a deep rut in wet fairways, they should stop and tamp down the area to reduce damage.

Larry T. and Harley both thought that the location of Tee Markers should be moved more often to protect the area from getting over worn. Frank will be addressing this. He has done a fine job of updating the out of bounds markers.

Luann spoke with Jessica regarding a "Statement from the Owners" to be

included in the Newsletter. They like the idea. Both Mens and Womens events have had problems "running into" other scheduled tournaments. The pro shop will be doing better planning/scheduling in the future. Harley said the path around the 18th tee box to the rest rooms needs repair. Casey will look into this.

Larry B. thanked Jessica for improving the condition of the swimming pool. The new maintenance people have done a great job and the members appreciate it. The pool is now closed, and the main gate to the courts is locked. For access to the courts, see the Pro Shop to request a key. He also mentioned two areas near the # 7 green that need attention. The split rail fence is broken beyond simple repair. Some of the main posts are broken. Also, the

fence around the maintenance pump to the right of the cart path is in horrible condition on the South side, which faces the neighbors. Three sides have been kept up and are in better condition, so most golfers don't see the problem (unless they live on Buena Vista).

Fred gave positive feedback regarding the Food, Chef, and Servers in the restaurant. He mentioned some dress code issues which he discussed with Jessica.
